The purpose of the day is to provide some insight into the career opportunities that an Electronics Technician has in the area of Information Technology. During this visit the student will be able to experience part of what is involved while training in our Electronics Engineering Technology-Information Processing Systems focus. This focus prepares students for exciting careers in Information Technology, which includes working on computers, computer networks, networking operating systems, and communication systems.

Limited space is available on a first come first served basis (you can send one to twenty students). The student(s) you recommend must:

- *Be a high school junior or senior
(with a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale)
- *Demonstrate positive citizenship and leadership skills
- *Be interested in pursuing an education and career in Electronics and Information Technology

This day will consist of hands-on, instructor led training that will teach the student the necessary skills needed to build, configure and test a Pentium 4 based computer. The students will also install and configure Windows XP. All PC components, tools, supplies, software and test equipment will be furnished by the college. We will offer the first class October 5, 2005 and we will have a class each Wednesday for a maximum of twenty students for 9 weeks.
