SAMPLE LESSON

Skill Area: Content Area Subjects

Language Stage: Speech Emergence

Outcome: Student will be able to add and subtract according to grade level.

Materials: Vocabulary and text being used at grade level, money and/or manipulatives

Procedure: How to count money, how to buy and count change. Use manipulatives to demonstrate addition and subtraction according to grade level.

Note: If basic math facts are not known, make or buy flash cards for home practice. Weekly time test to keep student motivated to study.

SAMPLE LESSON

Skill Area: Content Area Subjects

Language Stage: Speech Emergence

Outcome: Student will be able to recognize and match numeral values.

Materials: Dominoes

Procedure: Give each student a few dominos. Have a student place a domino in the middle of the table. Have another student match one of the numeral values represented on the first domino and state the number matched. Continue until all dominoes have been matched.

SAMPLE LESSON

Skill Area: Content Area Subjects

Language Stage: Speech Emergence

Outcome: Students will be able to match a number with its numeral value.

Materials: Teacher-made number cards, manipulatives (dried beans, coins, etc.)

Procedure: Have a student choose a card and name the number represented. The student then counts out a corresponding number of manipulatives. If the student correctly matches the number of manipulatives with the numeral value of the card, he or she keeps the manipulatives. If incorrect, the manipulatives are returned to the "pool." At the end of the class, have all students count all the manipulatives in their possession.
