

PHONE CONVERSATION

SAMPLE LESSON

Skill Area: Conversational Skills

Language Stage: Speech Emergence

Outcome: Students will be able to use a phone to convey information necessary in an emergency.

Materials: Play telephone

Procedure: Have the students provide emergency situations, e.g., fire, robbery, poisoning, etc. Pick one student to place the phone call and have the others choose the emergency. The student must make the proper call on the phone, i.e., call the police, ambulance, fire station, etc. Have another student be the person/agency being called. Allow all students to have a turn.

Note: This lesson can be used to teach survival responses.

SAMPLE LESSON

Skill Area: Conversational Skills

Language Stage: Speech Emergence

Outcome: Students will be able to converse on the phone by using short phrases and simple sentences.

Materials: Play telephone

Procedure: Discuss uses for the telephone: ordering a pizza, making a doctor's appointment, calling a friend, etc. Pick one student to be the caller and another to receive the call. Let the other students pick the situation to be acted out. The caller must make a call and ask questions or use phrases appropriate to the situation. Allow all students to have a turn.
