

## **SEQUENCING**

### **SAMPLE LESSON**

---

**Skill Area:** Literacy (Reading)

**Language Stage:** Speech Emergence

**Outcome:** Students will be able to retell a story in order of events.

**Materials:** A book or story appropriate for this level

**Procedure:** Read the story to the students. As you read, ask the students questions to prompt recall of key events. After you have finished, ask the students to retell the story, reminding them if necessary, of the importance of putting the events in order.

**Note:** Sock puppets, hand puppets or pictures attached to popsicle sticks could be used to facilitate the retelling of the story.

### **SAMPLE LESSON**

---

**Skill Area:** Literacy (Reading)

**Language Stage:** Speech Emergence

**Outcome:** Students will be able to create a story with a logical sequence of events.

**Materials:** Single pictures or a series of pictures illustrating a story/event

**Procedure:** Using the pictures as prompts, ask the students to arrange them in a sequential order. Next, have the students tell a story about the pictures, naming the characters, location and specific events. Make sure they have a beginning, middle and end to their story.
