SAMPLE LESSON

Skill Area: Thematic Vocabulary

Language Stage: Speech Emergence

Outcome: Students will be able to name and identify various items of clothing.

Materials: Pictures of various clothing items, paper, markers

Procedure: Give the students pictures of clothing and group them according to usage. Next have the students draw the outline of a human figure (stick figure will work) and position their groups next to the body parts associated with the clothing. The students will then create short sentences using the body parts and the clothing: e.g., you wear shoes on your feet; you wear pants on your legs, etc.

SAMPLE LESSON

Skill Area: Thematic Vocabulary

Language Stage: Speech Emergence

Outcome: Students will be able to choose clothing appropriate to a given situation.

Materials: Teacher-made situation cards

Procedure: Have a student choose a situation card: e.g., going to a pool, playing in the snow, invited to a birthday party, etc. The student must then describe attire appropriate for the chosen situation.
