## **SAMPLE LESSON**

**Skill Area:** Thematic Vocabulary

**Language Stage:** Speech Emergence

**Outcome:** Students will be able to recognize and name people with different occupations.

**Materials:** Pictures of occupations and occupation-specific equipment from magazines and/or newspapers, paper, glue, scissors

**Procedure:** Have the student select six occupations and find pictures of them. The student next matches the occupation with the equipment used to perform the job. Have the student glue the occupation and equipment on a sheet of paper, and then add any other appropriate information about each occupation. Have the students share their selections with the class.

## **SAMPLE LESSON**

**Skill Area:** Thematic Vocabulary

**Language Stage:** Speech Emergence

**Outcome:** Students will be able to recognize and name people with different occupations.

**Materials:** Pictures of various occupations

**Procedure:** Have students look through magazines and guess the occupations of those they see in the pictures. Riddles can also be created as a way to describe the person. The others will have to guess the person being acted out. Show the students pictures of other occupations and discuss the jobs. Now expand the game to include the new occupations.
