SAMPLE LESSON

- Skill Area:** Culture
- Language Stage:** Early Production
- Outcome:** Students will be able to give first and last names, along with their address and telephone number.
- Materials:** Cut-out forms of a house and telephone, students' phone numbers and addresses
- Procedure:** Each student will get a cut-out of a house and telephone. Every day, write one digit of their phone number or address on the appropriate form (if possible, have the students write the number). Have the students repeat the new number and then the whole sequence. Have the students repeat a phrase such as, "Hi, my name is Carlos Garcia and my phone number is ..." On day one, the student would only have one digit for the phone number (or address), on day two, two digits, etc. Do this daily until the phone number or address is complete.

Note: This lesson is a good daily warm-up exercise.

SAMPLE LESSON

- Skill Area:** Culture
- Language Stage:** Early Production
- Outcome:** Students will be able to involve the parent in the learning process to promote the home/school connection.
- Materials:** Teacher-made house cut-outs
- Procedure:** On the house cut-out, write the student's address. Send the cut-out home with the student and have the parents help in the learning of the address. Periodically check the student's progress.
