## SAMPLE LESSON

- Skill Area:** Thematic Vocabulary
- Language Stage:** Early Production
- Outcome:** Students will be able to identify animals and group them according to their environment
- Materials:** Pictures of animals from magazines
- Procedure:** Give the pictures to the students. Name the animals with the students. Ask the students questions such as: "Who has a ....?" "Does Rosendo have a horse or a cow?" On chart paper, have the students draw homes for the animals- a house, a farm, a zoo, etc. Group the animals according to their home.

## SAMPLE LESSON

- Skill Area:** Thematic Vocabulary
- Language Stage:** Early Production
- Outcome:** Students will be able to identify animals.
- Materials:** Pictures of animals for reference
- Procedure:** Have the students describe animals in riddle form. For example: "I am orange and black; I look like a cat; what am I?" Have the more advanced students use adjectives and/or comparatives.
