SAMPLE LESSON

- Skill Area:** Thematic Vocabulary
- Language Stage:** Early Production
- Outcome:** Students will be able to recognize and name numbers.
- Materials:** Pieces of paper with numbers written on them
- Procedure:** Place a sequence of three or more numbers on the table (chalkboard can be used instead of paper). Say the numbers and have the students repeat. Take away one of the numbers and begin counting. When you reach the missing number, have the students tell you the number. Now take away another number and repeat the process. Do this until all numbers have been removed.

Note: This lesson can be used in teaching the alphabet.

SAMPLE LESSON

- Skill Area:** Thematic Vocabulary
- Language Stage:** Early Production
- Outcome:** Students will be able to distinguish numbers by selecting and naming.
- Materials:** Number cards
- Procedure:** Give each student a set of cards (5-7 works best). Name a number and the students have to pick that number out of the cards they hold and say its name. Have the students take turns being the teacher by letting them ask the others to choose a number.

Note: This lesson can be used in teaching the alphabet.
