

ALPHABET

SAMPLE LESSON

Skill Area: Literacy (Reading)

Language Stage: Receptive

Outcome: Students will be able to match upper case letters with their lower case counterpart.

Materials: Individual cards for each upper and lower case letter

Procedure: Place all cards face down. One at a time, each student will turn over two cards. If upper and lower case letters are matched, the student keeps them and takes another turn. If a match is not made, the cards are placed face down and the next student takes a turn. After all cards have been matched, the students work together in placing them in alphabetical order.

SAMPLE LESSON

Skill Area: Literacy (Reading)

Language Stage: Receptive

Outcome: Students will be able to correctly alphabetize letters.

Materials: Paper

Procedure: Write one letter on each piece of paper. Give each student a letter (make sure you give a group of consecutive letters, such as ABCD or STUV, etc.) Students line up in correct alphabetical order and each one recites the letters shown.

Note: This is a good warm-up exercise. Take a few minutes daily, at the beginning of class, to do a group of letters.
