SAMPLE LESSON

Skill Area: Conversational Skills

Language Stage: Receptive

Outcome: Students will be able to respond appropriately to greetings and questions.

Materials: None

Procedure: Model a sample conversation starting with "Hello" or "Good morning." Teach the concept of a handshake accompanying an opening greeting. Follow the opening with the questions and close with "Thank you" or "Good-bye." Next, have the students hold the conversation in round-robin fashion.

Note: This skill can be reinforced by taking a few minutes at the beginning of class every day and using this lesson as a warm-up activity.

SAMPLE LESSON

Skill Area: Conversational Skills

Language Stage: Receptive

Outcome: Students will be able to respond appropriately to greetings and questions.

Materials: Play telephones

Procedure: Take turns calling each student and greeting them over the phone. Model the correct way to answer a telephone. Have the students call and greet each other over the phone. Encourage questioning such as, "How are you today?"
