

YES/NO RESPONSES

SAMPLE LESSON

Skill Area: Language Arts

Language Stage: Receptive

Outcome: Students will be able to correctly respond with yes/no answers to verbal questions.

Materials: None

Procedure: Using vocabulary areas already covered in class, ask the students a series of simple questions. For example, "Is the chair blue?" Also use nonsense questions such as, "Do you have four eyes?"

Note: This lesson, when used in conjunction with a vocabulary lesson, is good reinforcement of material covered and a way to check for understanding. Whenever possible, students should be encouraged to go beyond a simple yes/no response.

SAMPLE LESSON

Skill Area: Language Arts

Language Stage: Receptive

Outcome: Students will be able to correctly respond with yes/no answers to verbal questions.

Materials: None

Procedure: Using general classroom opening procedures—the date, weather, greetings (names), etc., question the students, "Is today _____? Are you (name)? Is it raining today?" etc. Be sure to ask a variety of questions that require both a positive and negative response.
