In the past, a large emphasis has been put on the requirements that the applicant be studying home economics. This requirement has been given some leeway. Therefore, the scholarship committee will consider any student whose career field is even remotely related to home economics.

Dear Applicant,

The **Morrill County Homemakers Scholarship** (\$200) is for any person that is a high school graduate or equivalent. (College applicants will be considered on an equal basis with high school seniors.) The scholarship may be used at any accredited (2 or 4 year) college that offers Home Economics degrees.

Applicants must complete the application form and submit three letters of recommendation from:

One of the following is required:
High School Principal
Guidance Counselor or advisor

Two of the following is required:
Teacher Clergy
Employer Extension Educator
Businessman (not relative)

A copy of the high school or college transcript must be attached to the application.

Any Morrill County **RESIDENT** graduate is eligible to apply for this scholarship. An applicant whose mother or grandmother is a member of a Morrill County Homemakers Club will be given first consideration by the selection committee.

The Morrill County Homemakers may call for a personal interview at their discretion.

Attached to this application is information showing positions held by UNL College of Home Economics graduates.
