1. All senior students who are interested in this scholarship to further their education to receive application form.
2. Student to have a "C" average or better.
3. Demonstrates a financial need for a scholarship. Such as have other members of family in college that places a financial burden on parents/guardians/grandparents, etc., study time vs. part time employment; have limited savings; and, needed in school for clubs and activities along with other needs.
4. Scholarship is to be used at a SCHOOL, in the State of Nebraska.
5. Student need not enroll in a program leading to a Bachelor's Degree, but rather may wish to pursue a course leading to a Vocational Technical Certificate or an Associate Degree at one of the Community Colleges.
6. Scholarship must not be used to supplement a Regents, Trustees, Presidents, or \$1,500 or more from other awarded scholarships.
7. All application forms from students to be received by your school's Scholarship Committee by April 20 of each year.
8. Scholarship Committee from your school to make selection on scholarship.
9. Your school to announce winner of scholarship (s) at honors night or graduating exercises.
10. Send your selection to the scholarship coordinator of the program by June 1. (See Back Copy)

VIRGINIA SMITH ENDOWMENT SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior from one of the 74 Nebraska High Schools selected to be part of the Scholarship Program.
2. Applicant must have a "C" average to be eligible.
3. Applicant must be able to demonstrate a financial need. Such as: have other members of family in college that places a financial burden on parents/guardians/grandparents; study time vs. part time employment; have limited savings; and, needed in school clubs and other activities.
4. Applicant need not enroll in a program leading to a Bachelor's Degree, but rather may wish to pursue a course leading to a Vocational Technical Certificate or an Associate Degree at one of the Community Colleges.
5. Scholarship must not be used to supplement a Regents, Board of Trustees, Presidents or receiving \$1,500 from other awarded scholarships, would make applicant ineligible for this scholarship. Should you find yourself in this situation, please visit your career counselor immediately.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Have one of your administrators, (Supt/Prin/Couns), a teacher of your choice, an employer, (if applicable) complete the recommendation form.
2. Return your application to your counselor. Counselor will be responsible for collecting recommendation forms. Employer should send their recommend to your counselor. (Check with counselor by April 20 to see if all forms have been completed and received.
3. Award winners will be notified on or before June 1.
4. The \$1,000 will be awarded on a one time basis and will not be renewable. A check for \$500 will be sent to your schools financial aids & scholarship office in August and an additional check for \$500 will be sent in December for the second semester.
