MARJORIE JANE STREEKS BROWN SCHOLARSHIP

History: Marjorie Jane Streeks Brown was born in Banner County, Nebraska in 1918 and lived an active farm/ranch life in Banner County. She was an excellent cook and an artistic seamstress. Marjorie was an active member of many community organizations. She was a strong supporter of education.

Purpose: This scholarship will be awarded to a third or fourth year college student accepted and entering a college or university with the goal of getting a degree in the field of medicine. This person must have graduated from **Banner County High School, Harrisburg, Nebraska**

Amount of Scholarship: 80% of the established interest will be awarded to the scholarship with the remaining 20% to be applied to the principle each year. If there is no applicant, the interest is to be added to the principle.

Eligibility: (a) graduated in good standing from Banner County High School (*Copy of High School Transcript required*)

(b) student in good standing attending an accredited College or University (*Copy of College or University Transcript Required*)

(c) emphasis of scholarship to be placed on academics, citizenship, community service and leadership

Application: To be issued through Regional West Foundation office in a timely manner to allow for proper application and selection of recipient. Application deadline is May 1st of each year.

Notice: The family of Marjorie Jane Streeks Brown is to put an announcement of the scholarship in the Official Banner County News Paper each February. The counselor in Banner County Schools, Nebraska colleges and University and Regional West Foundation will be given information about this scholarship by the foundation.

Selection: Is made by the members of the Regional West Foundation Scholarship Committee. The foundation members are to notify the family of Marjorie Jane Streeks Brown of the scholarship recipient. A name and address of a family member will be available to Regional West Foundation.

Award: The scholarship money will be sent the second semester to the college or university the recipient is enrolled.

Announcement: The announcement of the recipient of the Marjorie Jane Streeks Brown Scholarship shall be placed in the Gering Courier, and the Kimball Observer, in a timely manner by the family of Marjorie Jane Streeks Brown.

Please Note: Should Banner County High School consolidate with another school district in the future, this scholarship is to remain active only for a student who was a Banner County Resident during their four years of high school. In this case the applicant shall submit proof they were a resident of Banner County at this time
