Your help is needed to nominate one student from your school
to compete for a Burger King Scholars Award.
Just follow these three easy steps...

1. Nominate one high school senior from your school who meets these eligibility criteria:

- Has a cumulative high school/secondary school grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale or the equivalent.
- Works an average of at least 15 hours per week, for 40 weeks per year.
Employment at BURGER KING® restaurants is **NOT** required, although BURGER KING employees may be eligible students.
- Demonstrates participation in community service and/or co-curricular activities.
- Demonstrates financial need.
- Must obtain written recommendations/signatures from a school official and employer (neither can be related to the student). These recommendations are part of the application form – no separate letters are required.

Plans to enroll in an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school by Fall 2006.

2. Provide your school's nominated student with program guidelines and application form...

- Visit www.bkscholars.scholarshipamerica.org . Print the guidelines and application form for the student.
- If you have difficulties downloading or printing, e-mail bk@scholarshipamerica.org and indicate U.S., Canadian English or Canadian French version.

3. Follow-up with the nominated student to ensure application is postmarked by December 15, 2005.

- The nominated student must complete the application and submit with a current, complete and official transcript.
- Only the 2006 application form is eligible for consideration.
- Only one nomination per high school will be accepted for consideration.

This is a competitive scholarship program open to HS seniors only. Not all nominees will receive an award.
