I am excited to announce changes in the Eastern Wyoming College scholarships available for your students. Please find enclosed a copy of the new "Wyoming Border Scholarship." The criteria for qualification is a minimum 2.75 GPA or 21 ACT. If the student qualifies he/she will be entitled to pay only the in-state tuition rate and no fees for the first 12 credit hours.

As you know, Eastern Wyoming College offers many programs. Our largest technical programs are welding/machine tooling, cosmetology, veterinary technology, and criminal justice. EWC also provides excellent opportunities for students wishing to transfer on to other colleges and universities.

WYOMING BORDER SCHOLARSHIP

CRITERIA: Residents of states bordering Wyoming with a minimum GPA of 2.75 or 21 ACT

Continuing and Transfer Students must meet satisfactory academic progress eligibility requirements as established in the EWC Satisfactory Academic Progress Policies for Financial Aid.

CONTINUING ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Recipients must maintain a 2.50 semester GPA, successfully complete 12 credit hours, and meet satisfactory academic progress eligibility requirements as established in the EWC Satisfactory Academic Progress Policies for Financial Aid to continue receiving their award.

VALUE: The amount of the WUE difference plus 12 credit hours in fees for one year. (Students are responsible for in-state tuition rates and any additional fees beyond 12 credit hours.)

Preference is given to students in the following counties:

Colorado Counties: Logan, Morgan, Phillips, Segwick, Weld

Montana Counties: Carter, Custer, Fallon, Powder River, Rosebud

Nebraska Counties: Box Butte, Cheyenne, Dawes, Kimball, Morrill, ScottsBluff, Sioux

South Dakota Counties: Custer, Fall River, Pennington
